

2010 CO-ORDIT / EMRA RELAY

The RELAY has been formed to provide a track for talented young riders to get to the BSB paddock from Clubman to National status.

First Leg.

The EMRA 600 Formula and SSTK Championship 2010 run at Mallory Park where the 24 and under aged rider with the highest overall championship points will be given a free entry to the North Gloucester Road Racing Club 600 championship the following year 2011.

The only restrictions are that the rider is 24 or under at the start of the season and displays the co-ordit performance RELAY sticker on the fairing screen.

If the rider with the most points does not accept the entry in the NGRRC then it will be offered to the second place rider.

Second Leg

The NG Road Racing Club which covers the national circuits will run a RELAY championship for riders 25 or under in the 600 championship. The rider with the most championship points at the end of the season will win a ride in the 2011 British Superstock 600 championship. The rider will be given the use of a Yamaha R6 in co-ordit RELAY livery and paid entry in the BSB Superstock 600 championship in 2011.

The only restrictions are that the rider is 25 or under at the start of the season and displays the co-ordit performance RELAY sticker on the fairing screen.

If the rider with the most points does not accept the ride in 2011 then the ride will be offered to the second placed rider.

Third Leg

Riding in the Co-ordit Performance Team in the 2011 British Superstock 600 championship, the rider will be given the use of a Yamaha R6, suspension and race preparation, paid entry and the support of the team. The only restrictions are that the rider will have to fund tyres, fuel and crash damage.

Co-ordit Performance Relay Rules of Eligibility

The EMRA Co-ordit Performance Relay Championship is **open to riders aged 24 and under on 1 March 2010**. The NGRRC Co-ordit Relay championship is open to riders aged 25 and under on 7th March 2010. All Relay championships are run within the 2010 EMRA 600 Formula and Super Stock Championships, with the winner being the person within the age restriction who has accumulated the most points at the end of the season. All riders competing in the Relay championships must display the Co-ordit Relay sticker on the front of the bike and also nominate the class they intend to run in, we will not allow changes in mid season.
